Context of the Service system

- Child welfare work is becoming more complex
- Brighter Futures now further along Child Protection spectrum
- Growth in intensive programs beyond the statutory threshold
- Increased emphasis on family preservation and restoration

DV in Burnside's programs

Program group	Caseload at 30 April 2012	Current DV
Brighter Futures	451	224
IFBS	66	46

- 1 in 4 children witness DV in the home
(Indermaur 2011- Young Australians and DV)

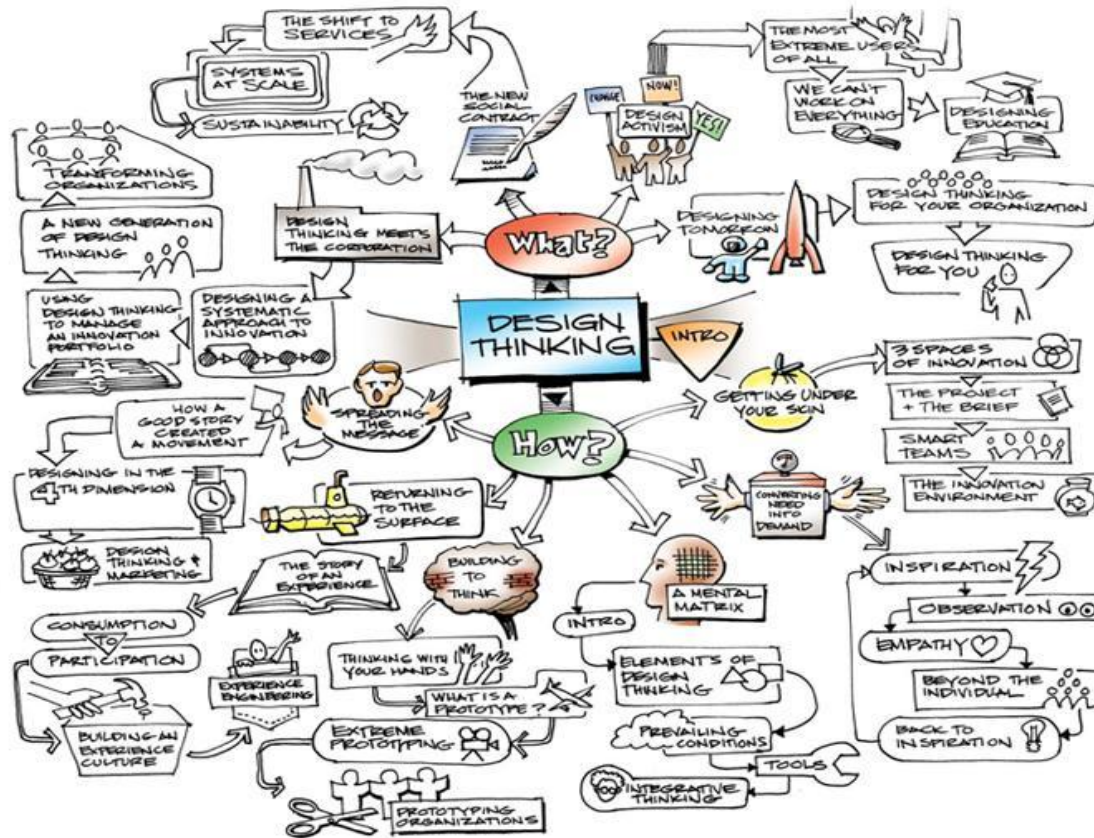
Brighter Futures Evaluation

- 2010 final evaluation report on Brighter Futures by SPRC
 - DV one of the most common reasons families were referred into program
 - Program was achieving some good outcomes in relation to DV
 - Recommendation to develop more targeted services for families impacted by DV

Burnside DV project

- Started in 2011
- Consultation with many internal stakeholders
- Wide ranging views on what we should achieve with project
- Literature reviews looking for evidence-based programs

Project got out of hand



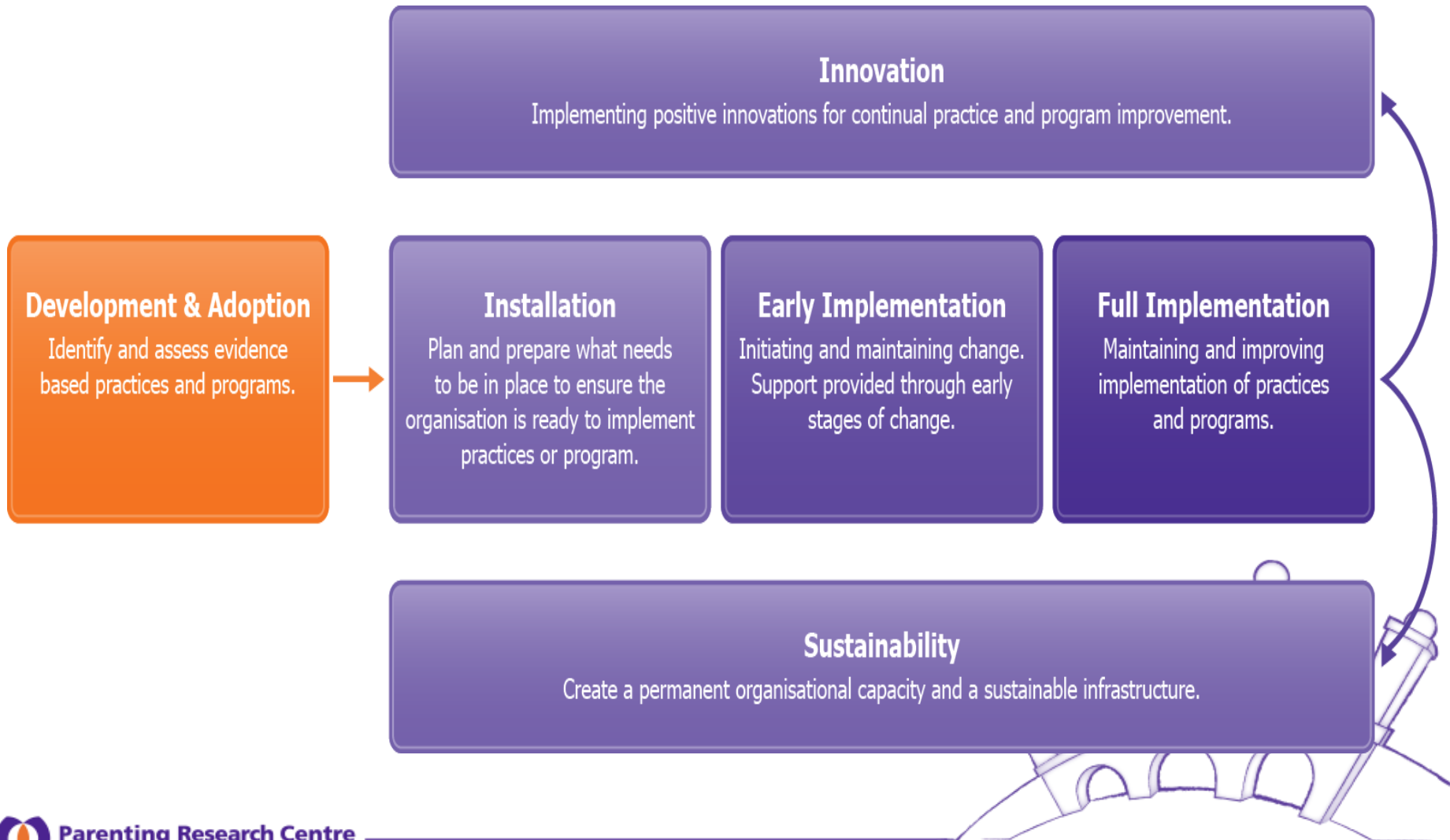
We lost our way



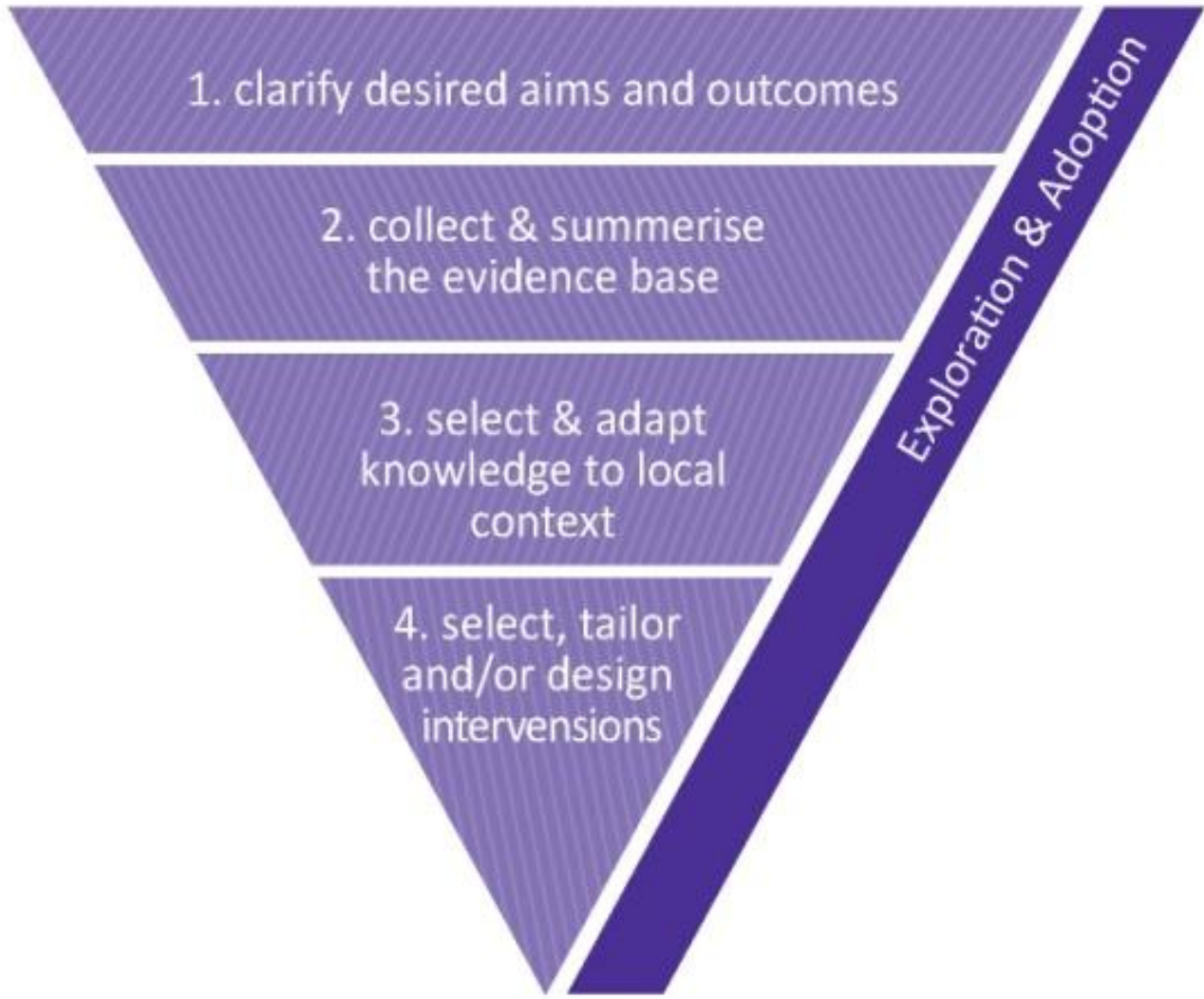
Implementation Science

Improve child and adult social connections and social support

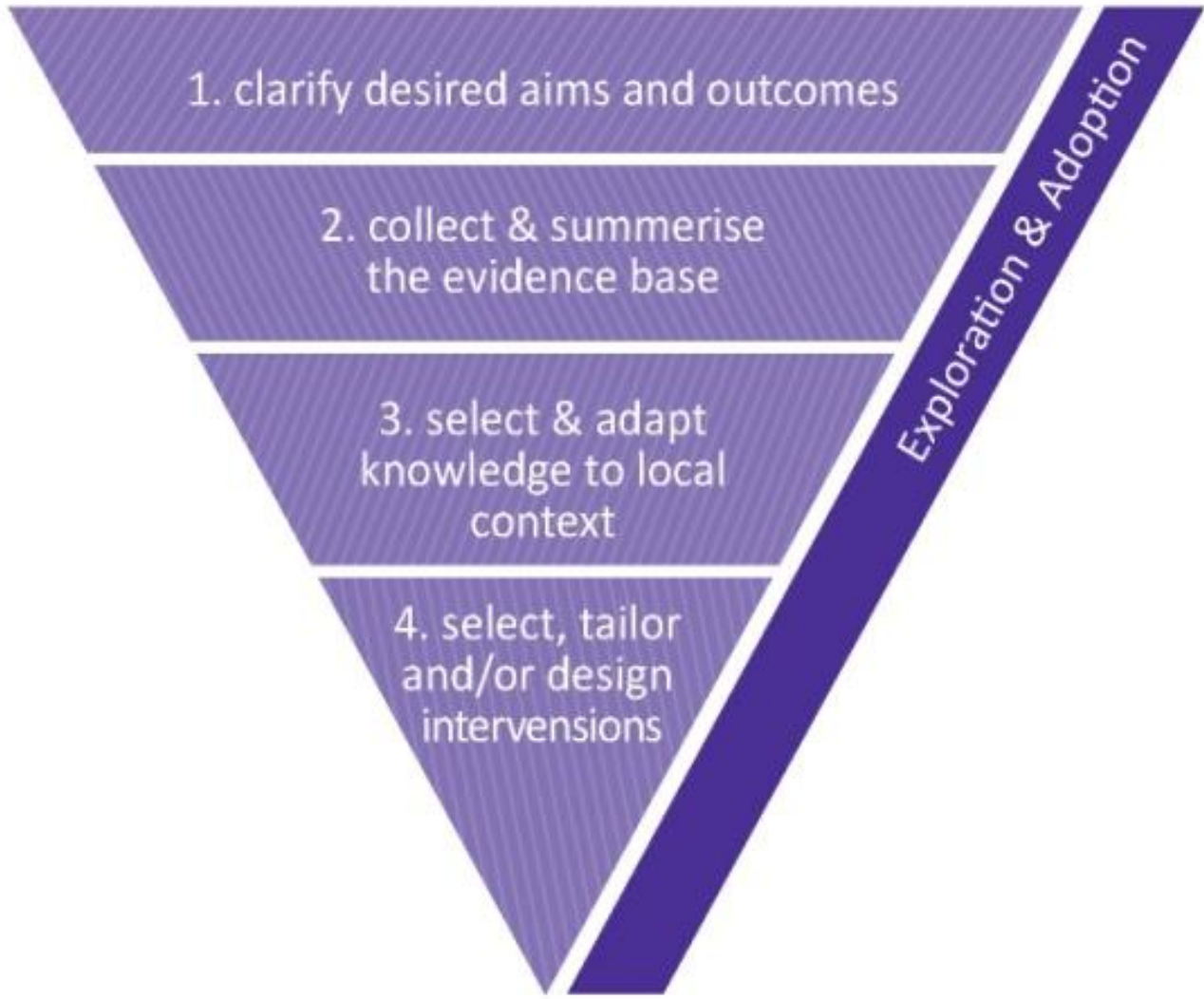
Improve child and parent problem solving skills.

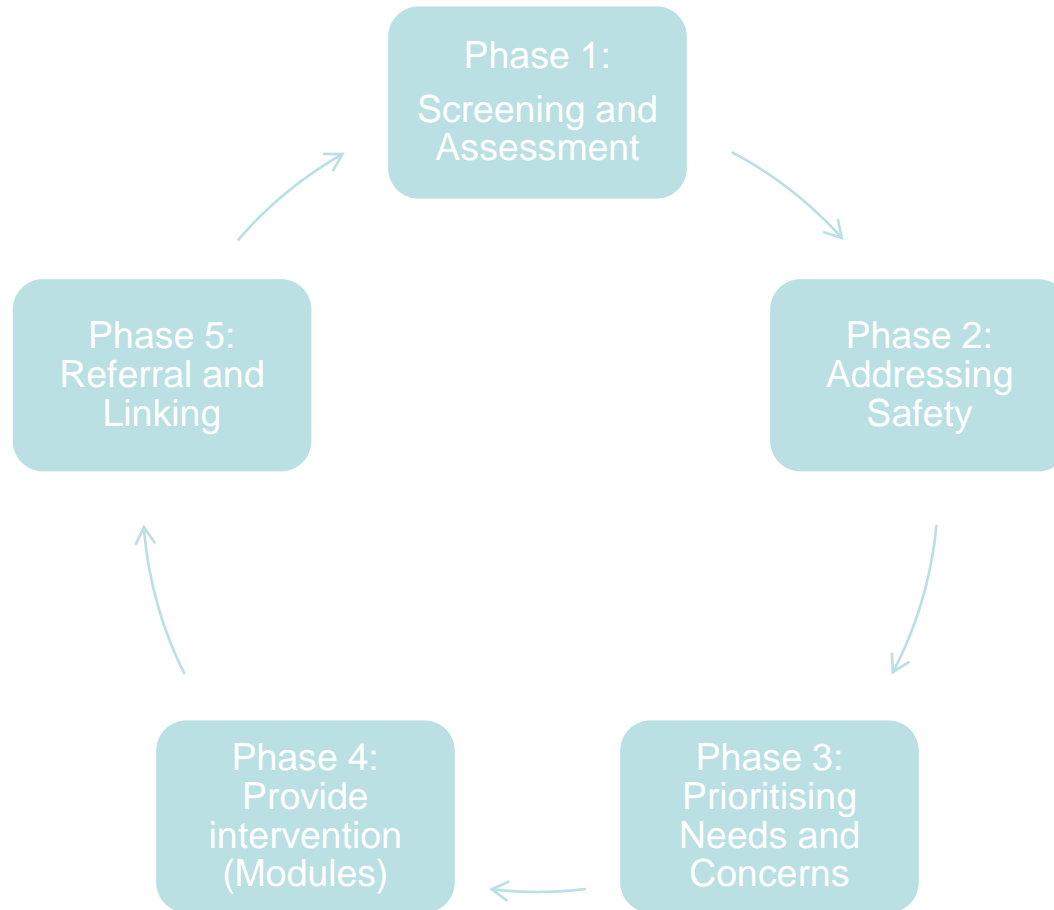
