Keeping Kids in Mind (KKIM) is a post-separation support program, offering, one on one support and group work to parents experiencing conflict and other complex issues after separation.

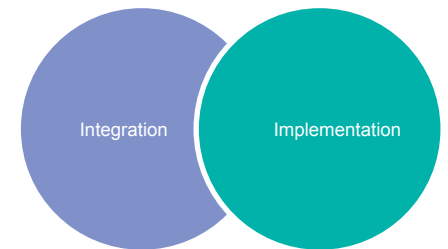
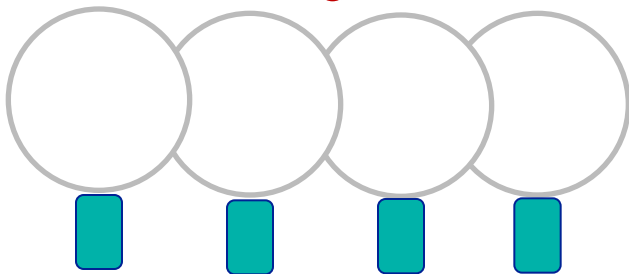
KKIM aims to improve the wellbeing of parents and children after separation through a suite of services, including:



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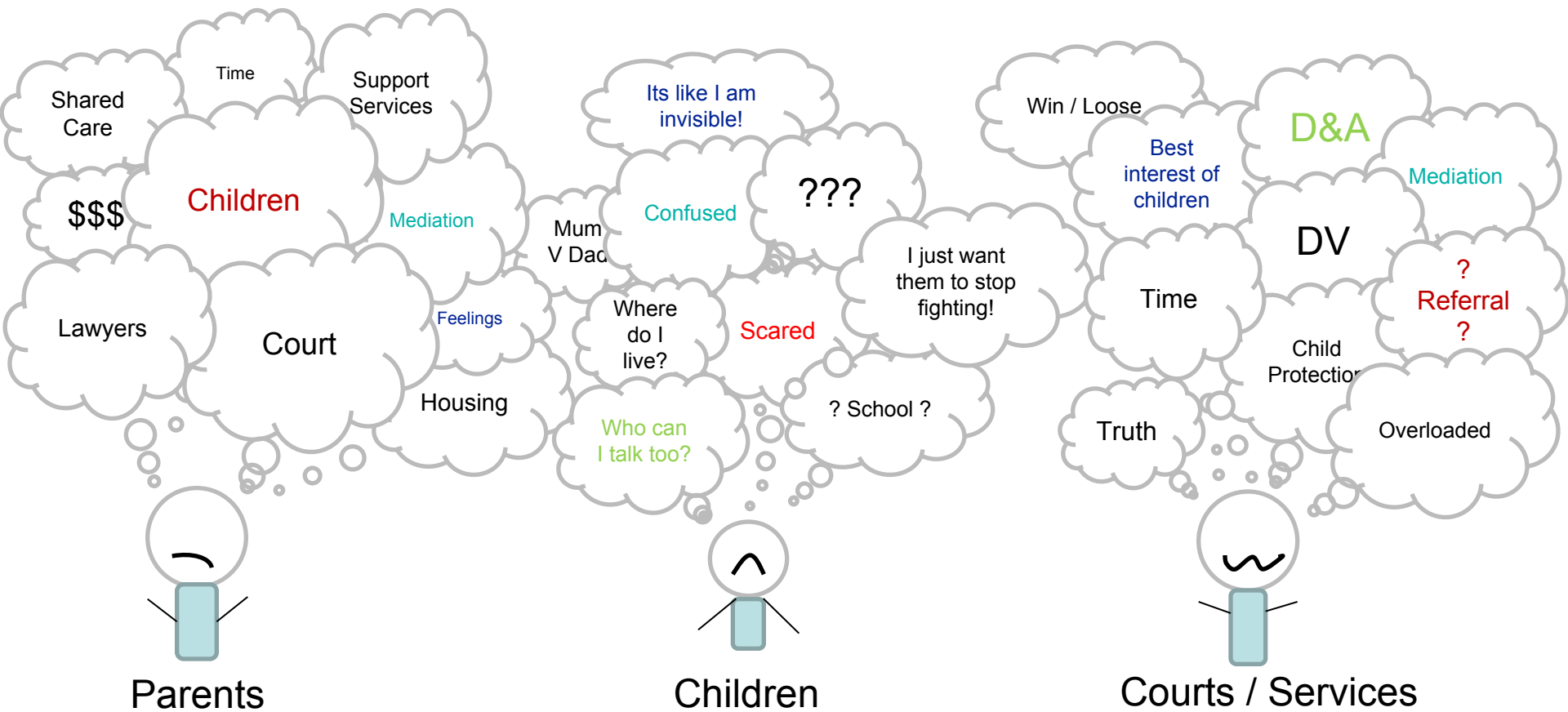

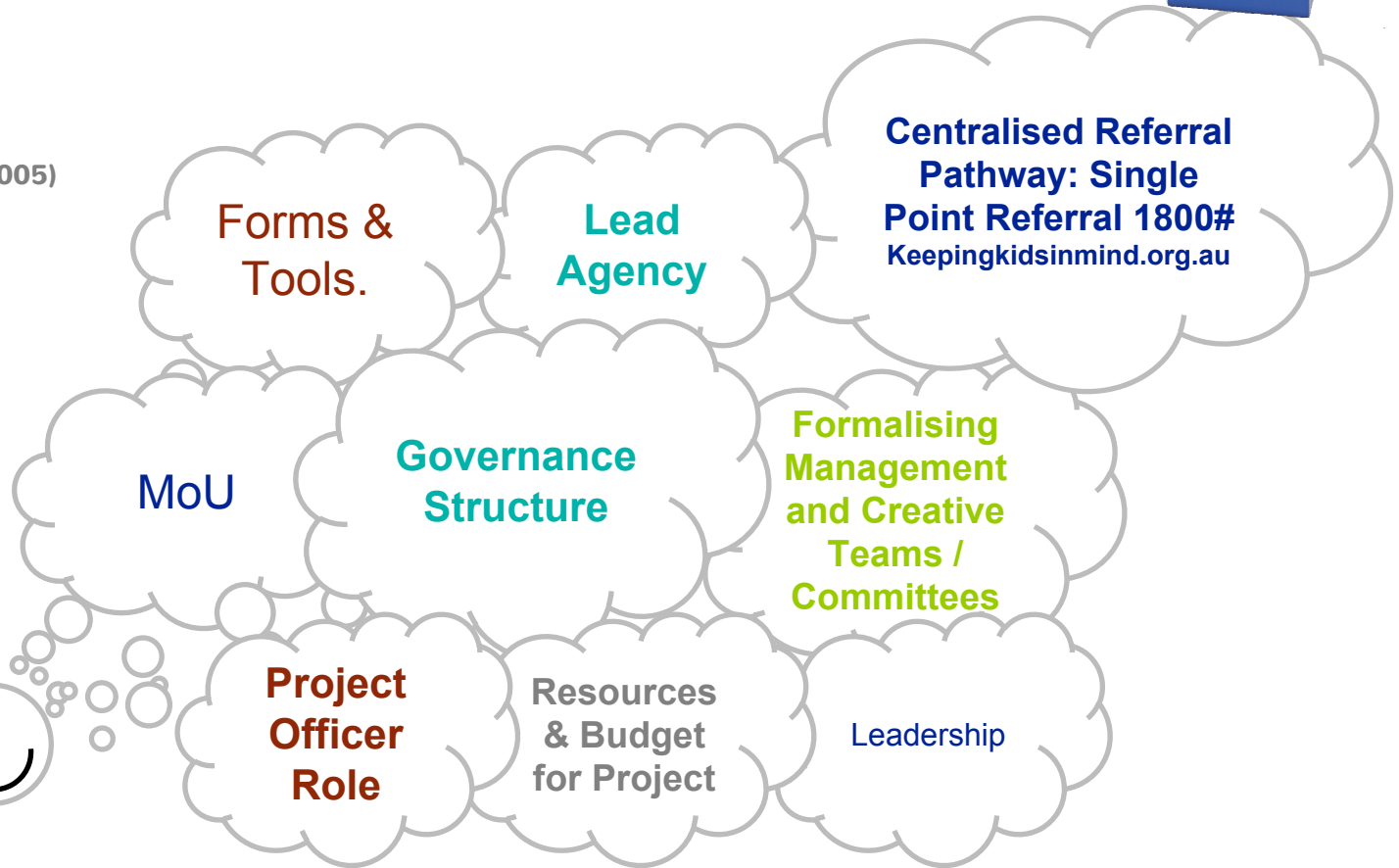


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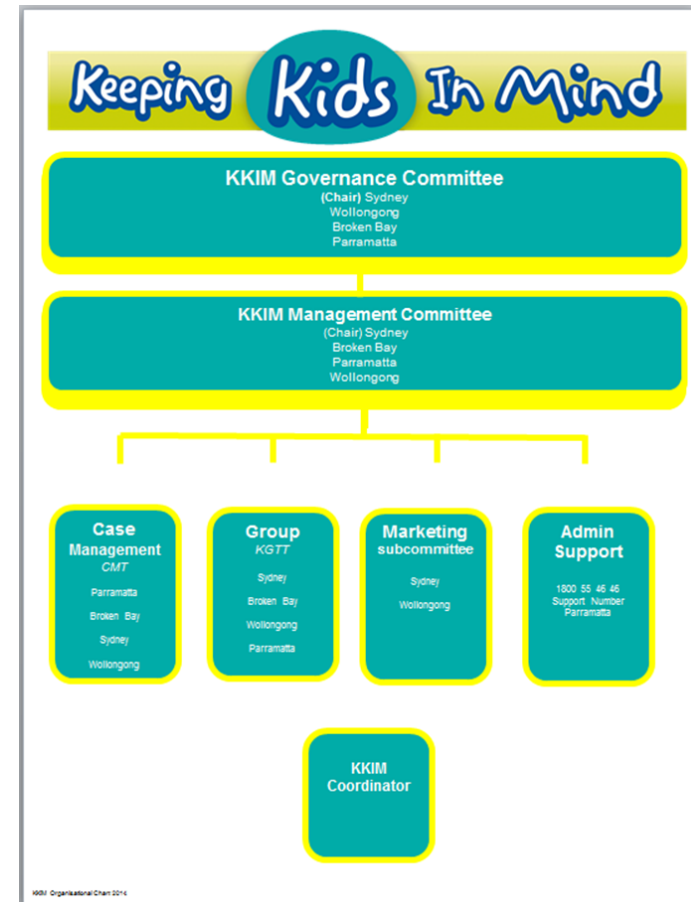
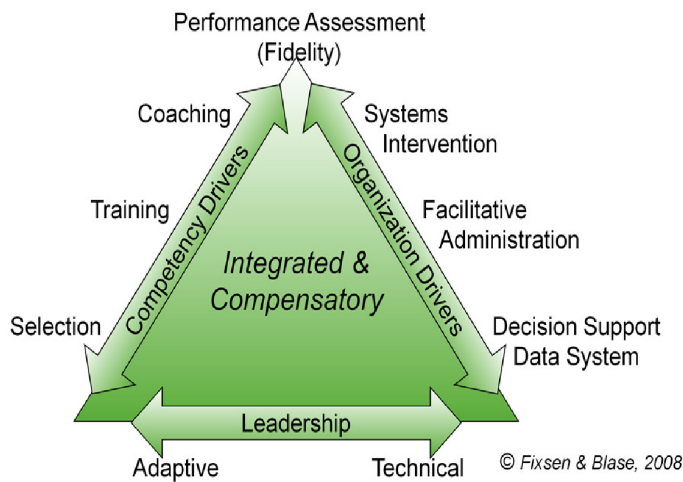
Installation:

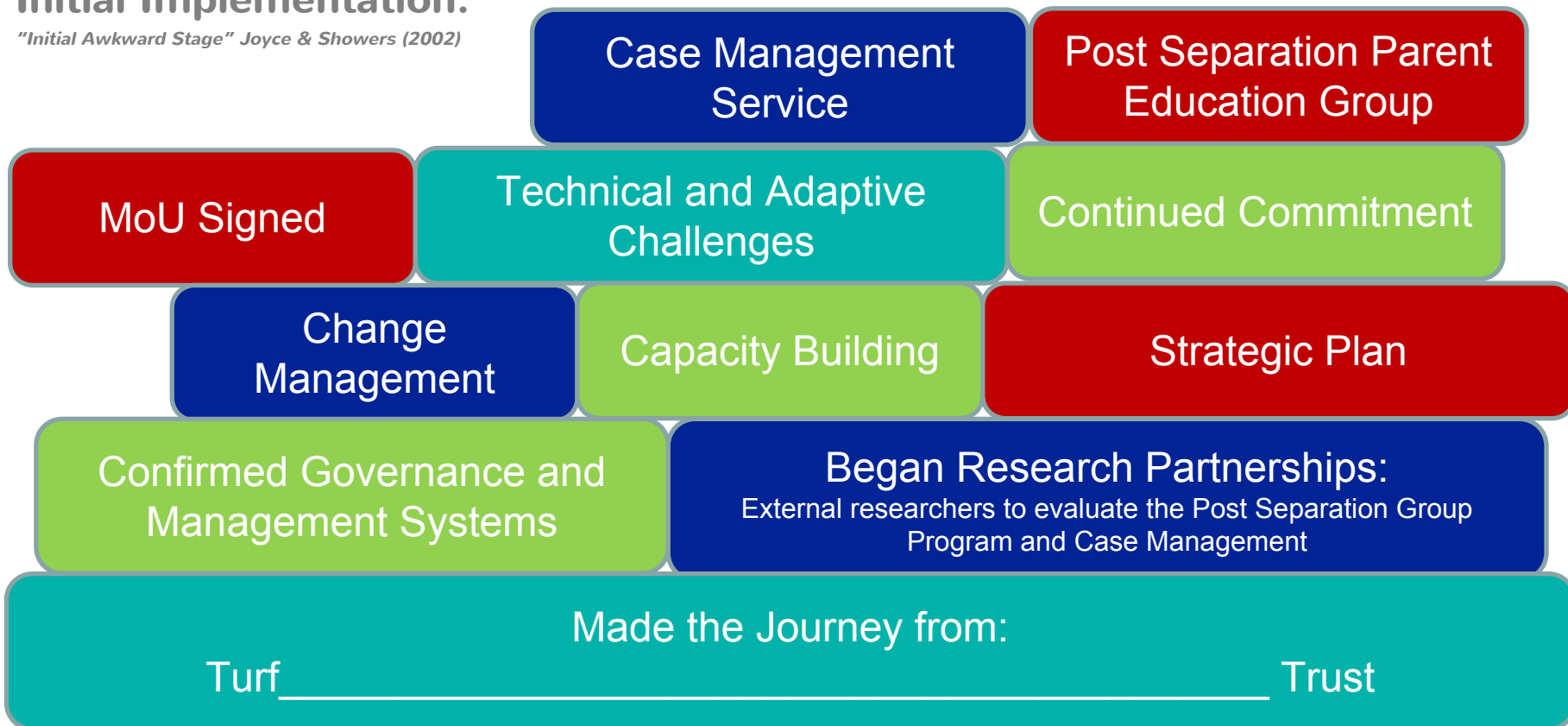

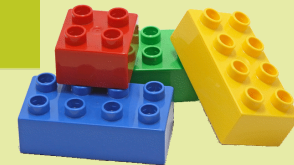
"Initial Awkward Stage" Joyce & Showers (2002)

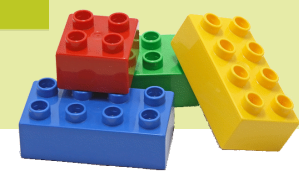
